



Health Savings Account (HSA) Amounts

In accordance with the United States Department of Treasury guidelines, please note the following amounts for 2009:

HSA Maximum Contributions for 2009

Individual:	\$3,000
Non-Individual:	\$5,950

HSA Minimum Deductible for 2009

Individual:	\$1,150
Non-Individual:	\$2,300

HSA Maximum Out-of-Pocket Limit for 2009

Individual:	\$5,800
Non-Individual:	\$11,600

Fund your HSA account until April 15, 2010

Contract holders with health insurance through a qualified High Deductible Health Plan (HDHP) during 2009 have until April 15, 2010 to fund their HSA account up to the maximum contribution limit.

Catch up contributions

Contract holders and their spouses, ages 55 to 65 with qualified HDHP coverage in 2009, can make an additional catch-up contribution of up to \$1,000 each to their HSA Account.
